## **Watercolor Melon Treat Box**

## Supplies:

- Stamp Sets Watercolor Melon (162962); Sweet Citrus (160641)
- Card Stock Basic White (159276)
- Ink Pads Tuxedo Black Memento (132708); Granny Apply Green (147095); Daffodil Delight (147094); Flirty Flamingo (147052)
- Misc. Scalloped Gift Card Boxes (161751); Modern Oval punch (162234); Black & White Gingham Ribbon (156485): Dimensionals (104430)

## Measurements:

- Basic White card stock: 5-½" x 2"
- Black & White Gingham Ribbon: 24"

## Instructions:

- 1. Stamp leaves in Granny Apple Green ink across box top while flat (it's the rectangle adjacent to the scallops). Optional: Stamp other parts of the box with leaves, as desired.
- 2. Stamp sentiment in black ink over the leaves.
- 3. Ink oval watermelon in Daffodil Delight ink, then ROLL the edges of the stamp around in the Granny Apple Green ink pad, getting close to the center, while leaving one end yellow. Stamp onto one end of basic white strip and punch out with Modern Oval punch.
- 4. Stamp two watermelon slices in Flirty Flamingo ink on the rest of the white card stock, adding Green rinds and black seeds, then fussy cut.
- 5. Adhere larger watermelon (with bite) on left front of box using any adhesive.
- 6. Add watermelon flavored treats inside the box (or gift card), then tie closed with gingham ribbon over the watermelon slice.
- 7. Add full watermelon and small slice to front of box with dimensionals.
