

Creative Haven Bookmark Card

Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Creative Haven (167202); or bundle stamps & dies to save 10% (167209)
- **Paper** – Card Stock: Cajun Craze (119684); Lost Lagoon (133679); Hobby Haven Designer Series Paper (167201)
- **Stamp Pads** – Versamark (102283)
- **Misc.** – Creative Haven Dies (or bundle with stamps, above) (167208); Forever Plaid 3D Embossing Folder (164049); Basic Beige $\frac{3}{8}$ " Classic Ribbon (165216); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Copper Embossing Powder- Metallics WOW! Embossing Powder (165678); Heat Tool (129053); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Magnet sheets (you could use a business card magnet from your fridge!)

Measurements:

- Cajun Craze Cardstock: 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " scored at 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ "; 11" x 2" scored at 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Lost Lagoon Cardstock: 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 4" and scrap for sentiment
- DSP: 4" x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ "; two pieces 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ "
- Ribbon: 5"
- Magnet sheet: two 1" x 3"

Instructions :

1. Emboss the Lost Lagoon card stock layer with the Forever Plaid 3D embossing folder, then adhere to card front with liquid glue.
2. Adhere 4" x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Designer Series Paper strip ONLY ON EACH END over the embossed layer, leaving the center unstuck (you'll be tucking the back of the bookmark behind it).
3. Fold the ribbon in half and adhere to top of bookmark on the folded end. Adhere the two 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " pieces of DSP on the front and back of the bookmark, covering the fold of the ribbon.
4. Let the two magnets attach to one another, making sure the magnetic poles work together, then adhere one to the inside front and one to the inside back of the bookmark, as shown.

- Stamp sentiment on Lost Lagoon card stock using Versamark ink and heat emboss with Copper embossing powder. Die cut sentiment with oval. Add to bookmark with dimensionals
- Slide the back of the bookmark behind the DSP strip on the card front, and let the magnets hold it in place.
